

BestExchangeRates.com International Scholarship 2018
Terms & Conditions

1. Website information pertaining to how to enter form part of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Participation in the BestExchangeRates.com (BER) International Scholarship 2018 (Scholarship) is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Applicants must fulfill the following criteria in order to be eligible to enter:
 - a. Be 18 years or over;
 - b. Be enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course at an Australian university;
 - c. Chosen field of study is within engineering, technology, science, media, journalism, business, finance or economics.
 - d. Be able to provide evidence from the university of acceptance and enrolment onto a course.
4. Applicants must submit the following in English, via email:
 - a. Current Resume/CV
 - b. A cover letter describing your academic achievements, interests and aspirations
 - c. Maximum of 400 words or a short video (no more than 4 minutes long) describing why this scholarship would assist in their future career
 - d. Verification of enrolment from the university/ confirmation letter of the course and institution where the applicant studies
5. The Scholarship period commences on 08 January 2018 (AEST) and ends at 11:59pm (AEST) on 18 October 2018 (Scholarship Period).
6. ONE scholarship winner will be selected for the Scholarship Period.
7. All valid entries for this Scholarship will be considered by a panel of judges with one Scholarship Winner announced. The Scholarship Winner will be notified by 20 November 2018.
8. BER reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions will be accepted at BER's discretion. Failure by BER to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
9. Any entry which is not in the English language, incomplete, indecipherable, inaudible, unviewable, or illegible will be deemed invalid.
10. Each entry will be individually judged based on creative merit. BER's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. The Scholarship winner will be notified by email and announced by 20 November 2018 on the BER website. Failure to claim the scholarship by 03 December 2018 will result in the reassignment of the Scholarship to the next best eligible entry as determined by the judges (Alternative Winner). The Alternative Winner will be notified by email by 07 December 2018. The Alternative Winner has two weeks from the day of notification in which to claim their Scholarship or another Alternative Winner will be selected.

12. The Scholarship is not transferable or exchangeable by the Scholarship Winner. The AUD \$1500 will be transferred into the Scholarship Winner's nominated **Australian** bank account.
13. Applicants consent to BER using the Winner's name, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a winner (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media for an unlimited period without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this Scholarship.
14. If this Scholarship is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of BER, BER reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any Entrant; or (b) to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Scholarship, as appropriate.

Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, BER excludes all liability (including negligence), for any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Scholarship, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following: (a) unauthorised access or third party interference; (b) any entry that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Scholarship) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of BER; or (c) any tax liability incurred by a winner or Entrant. It is a condition of accepting the Scholarship that the winner may be required to sign a legal release in a form determined by BER.
16. BER collects personal information in order to conduct the Scholarship and may, for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties, including but not limited to agents, and contractors. If we send your information outside of Australia, we will require that the recipient of the information complies with privacy laws and contractual obligations to maintain the security of the data. Entry is conditional on providing this information.
17. All entries submitted become the property of BER. Entries will not be returned to any Entrant. Unless otherwise indicated by you, by participating in this Scholarship you are agreeing to us providing you with information in relation to the services and products of BER.
